2015 Lacrosse Rules Changes. 1-6-2: Adds an additional stick check procedure to ensure that the ball will roll out of the top end of the head. 1-7-3: Specifies that any hanging strings or leathers cannot be more than 2 inches in length and, beginning in 2016, that shooting strings and V channels must be within 4 inches of the top of the crosse.
