Measurer: Record the measurement on the data collection sheet under "Recumbent Length". Check to make sure it is accurate and legible. This will be your length. Next, measure the shorter side of the package, or the width. Finally, turn your tape measure perpendicular to the previous angle and measure the height of the box. Multiply the width and height measurements by 2, but not the length. Add these 2 numbers together to obtain the girth of the box.

How to Measure the Length x Width x Height of Shipping Boxes

- Measurements of weight and height must be accurate and recorded according to facility policy, because medications may be ordered according to the patient's size. - Height measurements may be recorded in feet (') and inches (") or in centimeters (cm). - Weight measurements may be recorded in pounds (lb) or kilograms (kg).

Ideally height measurements will be taken using a 'drop down' tape measure fixed at about 2metres on a wall or a specific piece of measuring equipment as shown adjacent.
