List of Prophets of the Old Testament

The Old Testament describes a prophet as follows: 1) a man of God (1 Samuel 2:27); 2) a servant and messenger of the Lord (Isaiah 42:19); 3) a seer (Isaiah 30:10); a man of the Spirit or "inspired man" (Hosea 9:7); a watchman for the people (Ezekiel 3:17). Prophets of the Old Testament List and Bible History ...

Prophets such as Ahijah, Elijah, Jonah, and Isaiah are also called servants of the Lord (1 Kings 14:18; 18:36; 2 Kings 14:25; Isaiah 20:3). Samuel's mother, Hannah, describes herself as a servant of the Lord in 1 Samuel 1:11. Zerubbabel, governor of Judah, is described as a servant of the Lord in Haggai 2:23.
