Locate and select the folder that appears missing in Outlook, and check the value of the PR\_ATTR\_HIDDEN to determine if it is set to True, as shown in the following figure: If PR\_ATTR\_HIDDEN shows a value of True, right-click the PR\_ATTR\_HIDDEN property and select Edit Property. Uncheck the Boolean checkbox and click OK.
