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Timed Vs Untimed Cpt Code

Untimed codes may be reported once per day, regardless of the length of the session. Examples include CPT codes 92507 (Treatment of speech, language, voice, communication, and/or auditory processing disorder; individual) and 92557 (Comprehensive audiometry threshold evaluation and speech recognition).

Time-Based vs. Service-Based. So first, let's talk about the difference between time-based and service-based CPT codes. You would use a service-based (or untimed) code to denote services such as conducting a physical therapy examination or re-examination, applying hot or cold packs, or providing electrical stimulation (unattended).

The minimum time for one 15-minute code is 8 minutes. Two units would be a minimum of 15 + 8 minutes = 23 minutes. This rule is extended to multiple units in the following CMS table: 1 unit: 8 minutes to < 23 minutes 2 units: 23 minutes to < 38 minutes 3 units: 38 minutes to < 53 minutes 4 units: 53...

Timed & Untimed Codes FAQs

Untimed Codes. Untimed Codes are billed one unit per date of service regardless of the number of anatomical body areas treated. It does not matter if you spend 2 minutes or an hour treating the patient using these codes, you can only report one unit per code. The following codes are untimed codes:

The language in the constant attendance modality codes indicates that these codes are reported once for each 15 minutes of service. For example, if manual electrical stimulation is applied to four areas for a total of 30. minutes, CPT® code 97032 is reported for two units, once for each 15-minute interval.

For any single timed CPT code in the same day measured in 15- minute units, providers bill a single 15-minute unit for treatment greater than or equal to 8 minutes through and including 22 minutes.

Remember, you only count the timed code minutes and you must ignore the untimed code minutes. For the individual codes, you need to code based on the following rules: If a service represented by a 15 minute timed code is performed in a single day for at least 15 minutes, that service shall be billed for at least one unit.

Most CPT/HCPCS codes reported by speech-language pathologists are untimed and do not include time designations in the code descriptor. An untimed code is billed once per day, regardless of the time spent providing the service.

Medicare Coding Rules for SLP Services

Untimed codes: The PT is paid a predetermined fee regardless of the time of treatment application or the number of body areas being treated. These codes can only be billed once per treatment session.
